Dalham Village Hall was constructed in 2010.

The Village Hall has been designed and constructed to meet building standards current in 2010 which allows for access, egress and hygiene facilities for those with mobility disabilities.

The building is single storey and has a number of emergency exits to the outside, all of which can be used by those with mobility problems.

The Village Hall Committee is committed to ensuring that, so far as is reasonable, use of the Village Hall is open to all and wishes to comply with its various duties and obligations for reasons of the Equality Act 2010.

The Village Hall Committee would ask to be contacted if a potential individual user of the Village Hall feels that the facilities offered, do not allow in that individuals case, safe or appropriate access or use. The committee will then assess the circumstances before considering any reasonable adjustments which may be required to accommodate that individual.
